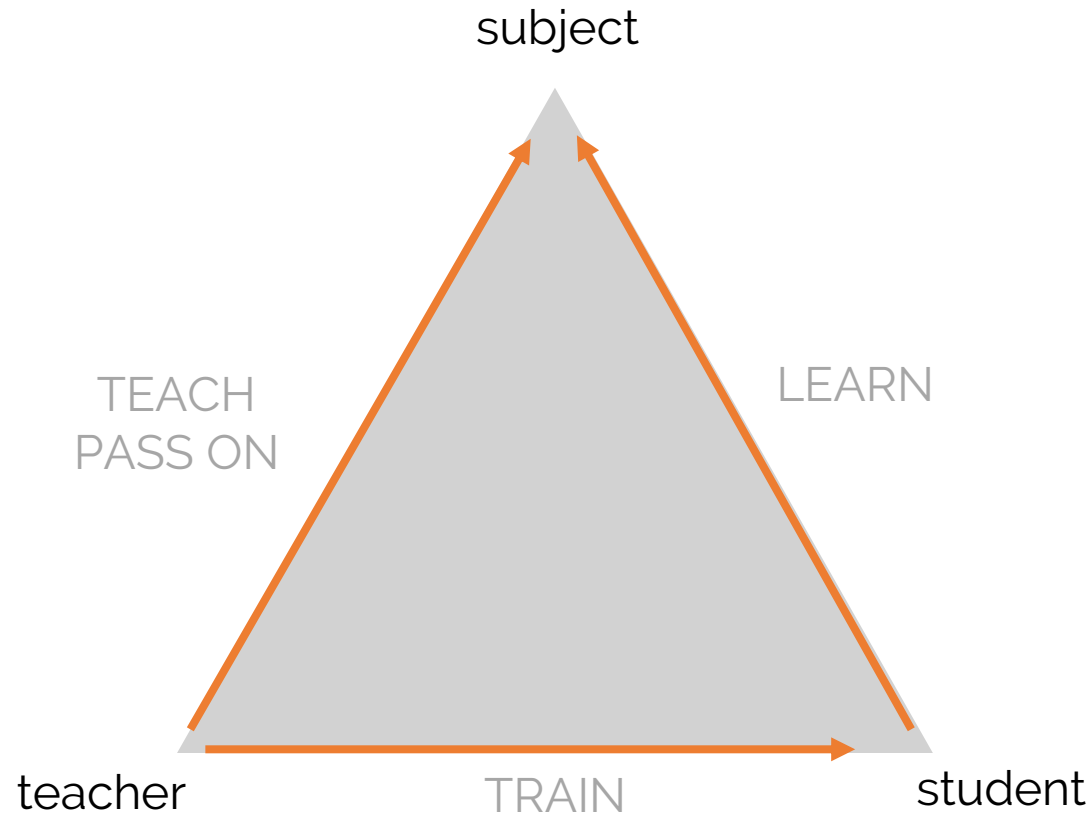

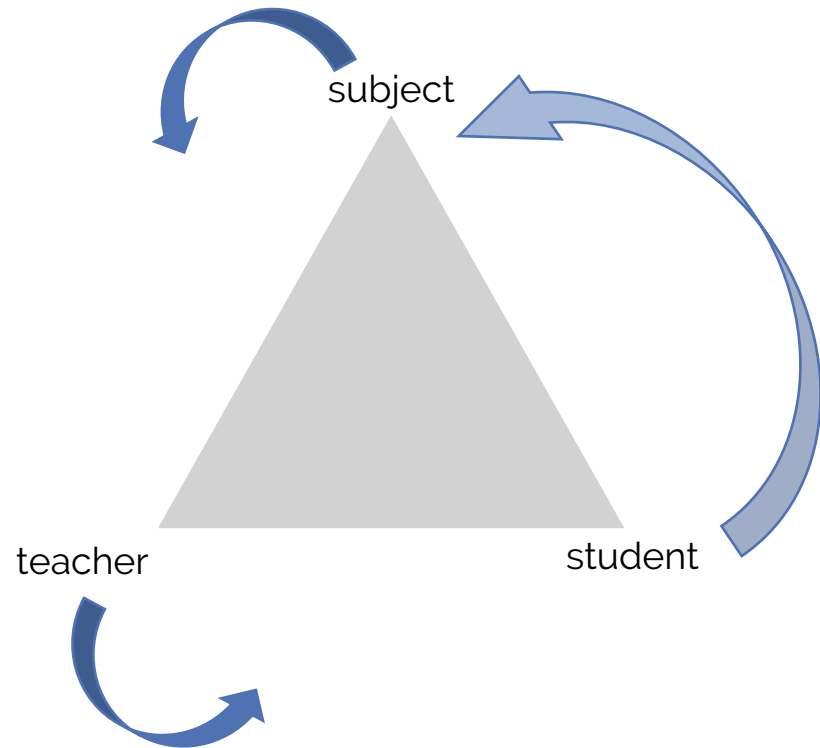
The educational triangle



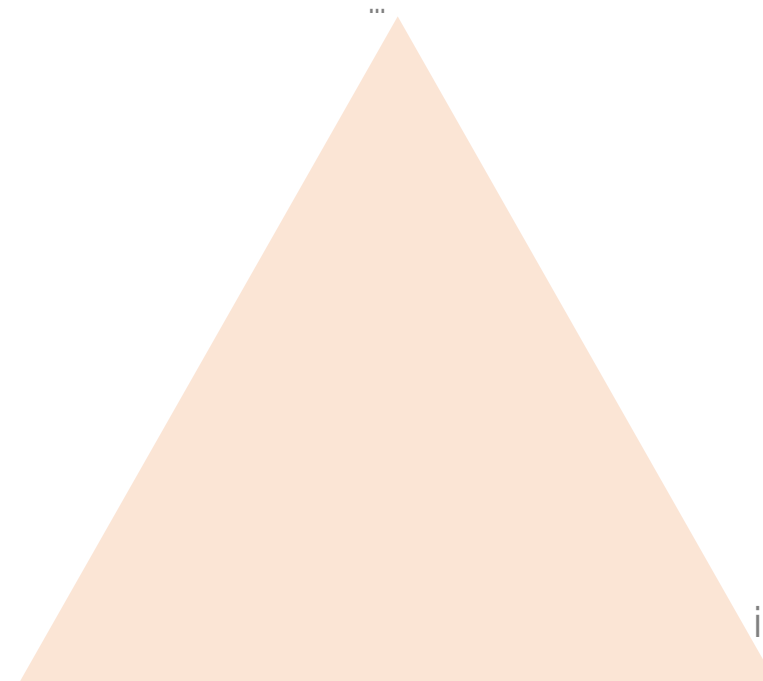
The conventional educational triangle

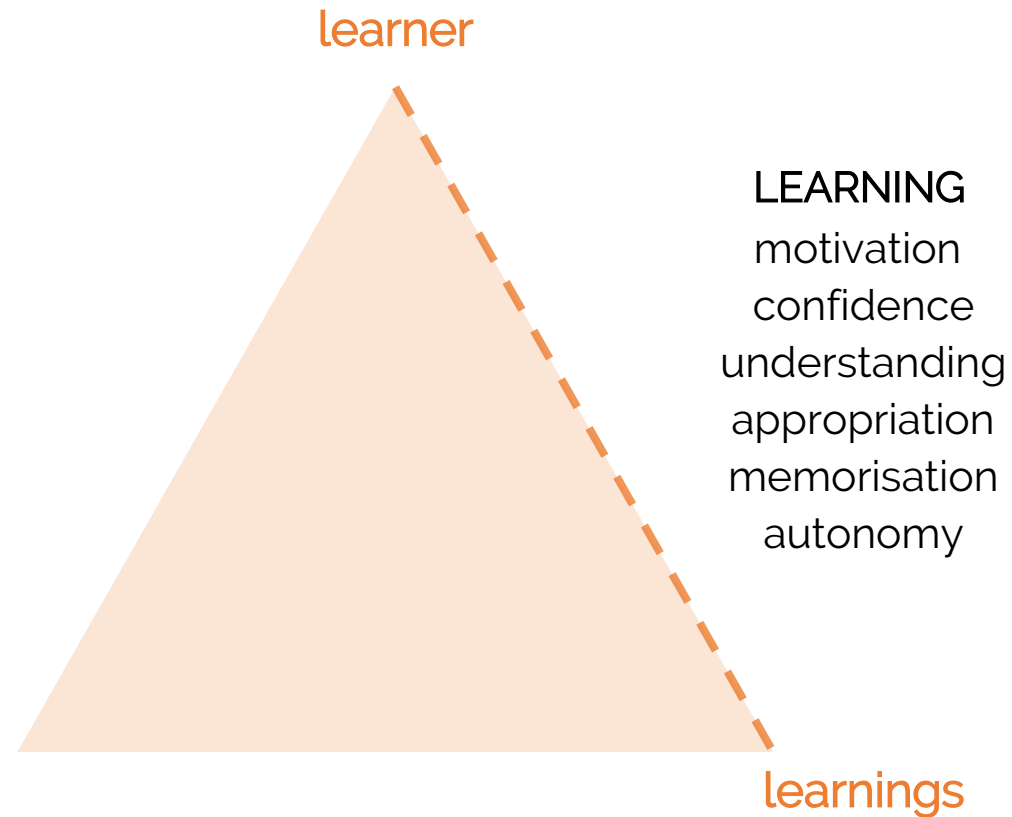

The triangle's 3 axes

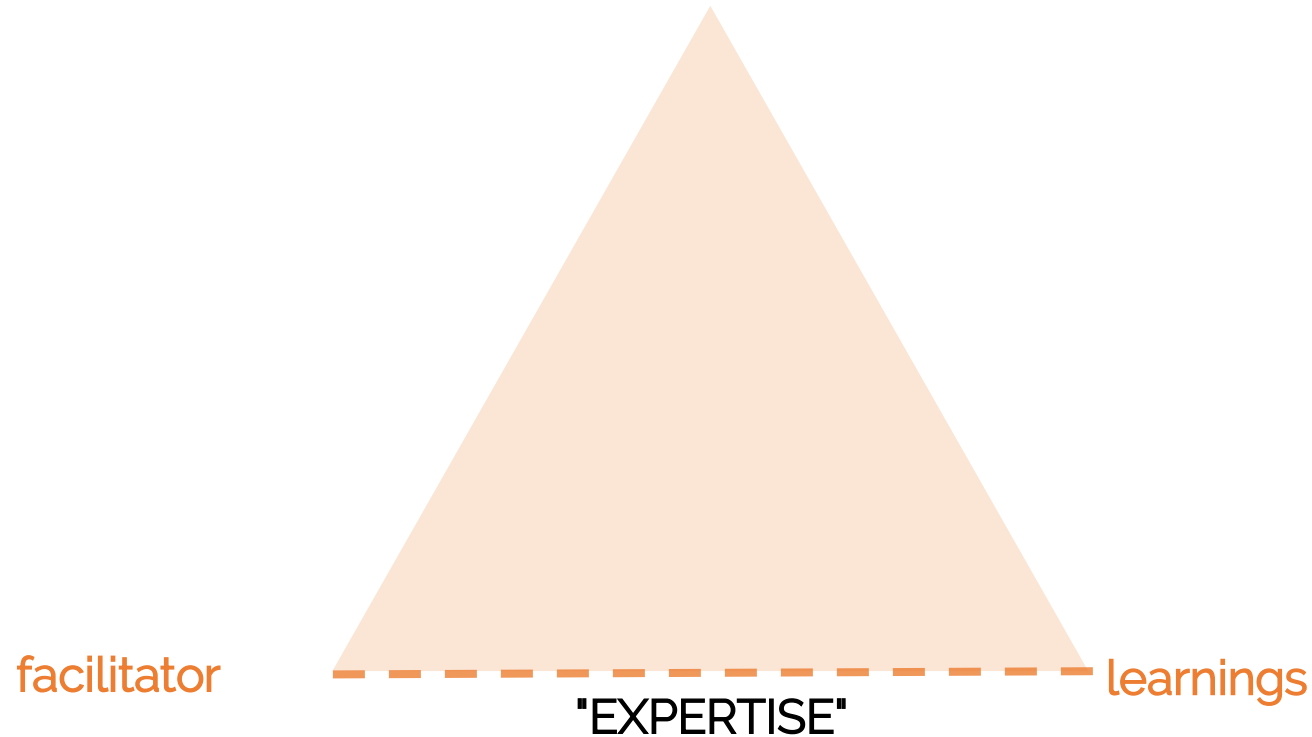
... a little more closely

The facilitator/learnings axis all about expertise in several domains !



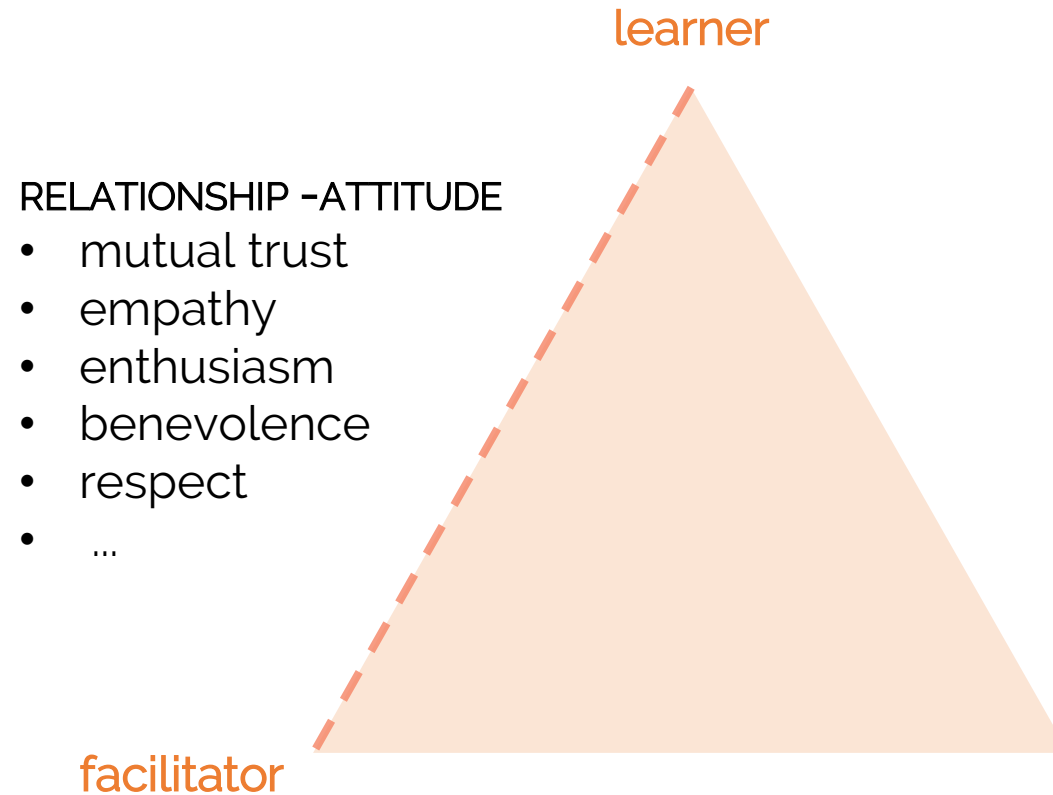
KNOWLEDGE/UNDERSTANDING

The facilitator/learner axis a certain attitude for a quality relationship

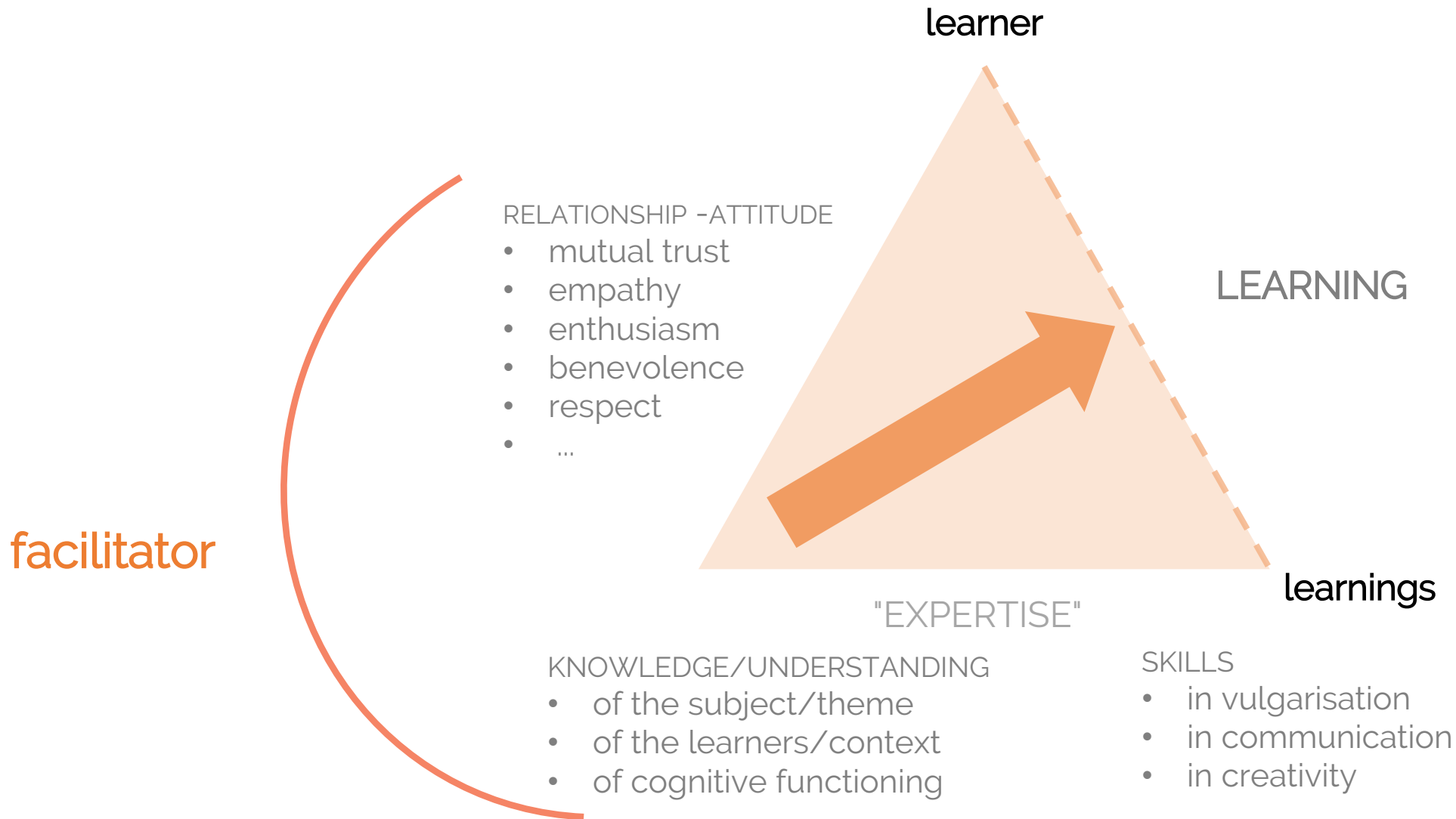

IN SHORT

What can this triangle do for me, in practical terms ?

- It gives me a reflexion framework that enables me to identify domains I can reinforce or aspects for which I can seek help/support.

Am I comfortable with the content itself (mastery of digital skills) ?

Am I familiar with my public's / the context's specificities ?

Can I see how to present / liven up contents in an attractive, clear, interesting, pertinent way ?

- I can review the type of relationship and spirit I wish to create.

What matters to me ? How does that translate in terms of behaviour ? How can I achieve this, in practical terms ?

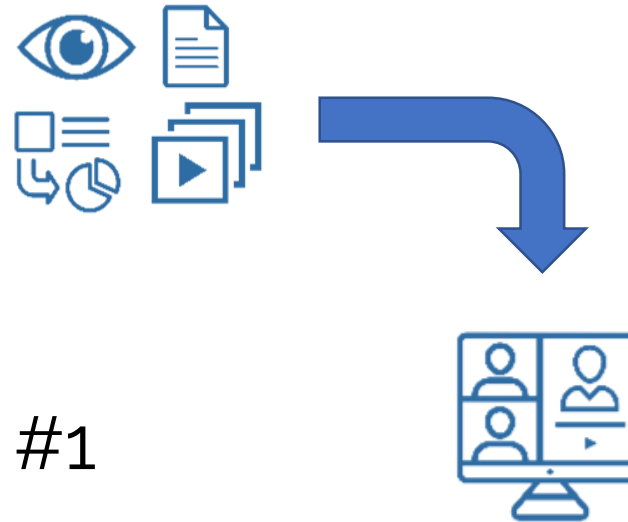
- I can release the pressure of what is expected from me, of which position to take during these workshops.
